Dear Chapter President,

Each year, the Houston Alumnae Panhellenic Foundation awards scholarships to undergraduate members of National Panhellenic Council (NPC) sororities who are permanent residents of Harris County, Texas and graduated from a high school in Harris County, or one of these contiguous counties: Brazoria County, Chambers County, Fort Bend County, Galveston County, Liberty County, Montgomery County, and Waller County. (Harris County covers most of the Greater Houston area.)

The students must be enrolled full-time and may attend any accredited college or university in the United States. Selection of scholarship recipients is based upon financial need, scholarship, and involvement in extra-curricular activities including sorority participation

Last year \$70,500 in scholarships, ranging from \$2,000 to \$5,000 each, was awarded to 25 collegiate women.

The application has been updated for this year and is available online. Detailed instructions are given in the application.

Please encourage applicants to start early requesting personal recommendation letters from their chapter Adviser and a college professor or teacher. The process always takes longer than expected!

### **APPLICATIONS MUST BE POSTMARKED BY FEBRUARY 15, 2018.**

Application packets are accepted any time prior to the deadline. Applicants may mail their application just as soon as it is completed. Award winners will be notified by April 1, 2018 and the scholarships will be awarded at the HAPF May 3, 2018 Scholarship Luncheon. Scholarship winners and their guest are invited to attend the luncheon to receive their award; however, attendance is not mandatory.
