Dear HAPA Delegate:

Do you know about the fantastic Houston Alumnae Panhellenic Foundation Scholarships? They are awarded every year at the annual Houston Alumnae Panhellenic Association and Foundation luncheon, which this year will be held on May 4, 2023, in the Junior League of Houston ballroom.

Applications and information concerning HAPF scholarships can be found online at the website [www.houston-panhellenic.org](http://www.houston-panhellenic.org). Copy and paste the URL and click on the tab "Scholarships". The scholarships are awarded to young women who graduated from a high school in Harris, Brazoria, Chambers, Fort Bend, Galveston, Liberty, Montgomery or Waller County.

Undergraduate students who are members in good standing of a National Panhellenic Conference sorority, who are full-time students (12 hours or more per semester or as defined by their college or university), and who will be enrolled for fall and spring semesters 2023-2024, are eligible. The scholarships are based on need and may be applied ONLY TO TUITION at their university. Those with a full tuition, scholarship, or grant are not eligible.

As a HAPA delegate, it is your responsibility to promote the HAPF Scholarships within your respective group and your collegiate chapters. Please share the Scholarship Flyer with your Alumnae groups, Mothers'/Parents' Clubs, and Collegiate Chapters to inform them about the HAPF scholarships.

How do you start to contact the collegiate chapters?

- Contact your sorority National Headquarters to obtain contact information for your college chapter advisors and chapter presidents. At the minimum, contact all your Texas chapters but also determine if other states may have eligible members, for example, Louisiana, Oklahoma, Alabama, Georgia, etc.
- In October, email both the chapter advisor and president to encourage all qualified, active collegiate members to apply, and to **BEGIN EARLY** to acquire all of the required information. It takes longer than anticipated to obtain letters of recommendation from the chapter advisor, official college transcripts, and to write a quality letter containing personal information to explain why the financial assistance is needed.
- Include the Scholarship Flyer that summarizes the eligibility information. Do not send bulk emails as they may go to a spam account.
- Follow-up in subsequent months to remind the collegians about the scholarships and the deadline (November, December, and January).
- You may also want to contact any Regional or Province directors to enlist their support.
